Terms of Sale For Buyers: Cash or valid check made to NEJBA. All lots must be off the grounds the evening of the sale. Embryo lots must be paid for up front and shipping costs are paid by the buyer. Cowbuyer will be available for bidding during the sale- in which the buyer will be billed for their purchase

Sales Commission: Commission for this sale is as follows: lots selling up to \$1,000 will pay a flat fee of \$150.00. Lots selling 1,001 + will follow the rates below:

REGISTRATIONS AND SIGNED TRANSFERS MUST COME WITH EACH LOT. Transfers will be completed at the consignor's expense. Buyers will **NOT** receive registration papers until payment has been received by NEJBA and checks have cleared.

### **Health Requirements**

1. Official Interstate Health Certificate
2. Official USDA ID- 840 RFID tag required
3. Please see Rhode Island health requirement attachment
4. Testing
  - a. Brucellosis- the following animals, at the time of importation, shall be negative to an official test for brucellosis within 30 days before importation:
    1. Bulls and non-brucellosis vaccinated female cattle 6 months of age and older.
    2. Official calfhooD vaccination 18 months of age and older
  - b. Tuberculosis-all animals shall be negative to a TB test within 30 days prior to entry (60 days not 30 – based on the fact that an intradermal test TB test cannot be administered less than 60 days from a previous test.
  - c. BVD-PI negative test is required for all animals.
5. Vaccination Requirements



- a. A current rabies vaccination is required for all animals over 4 months of age.
- b. Bovine Respiratory Disease Complex – IBR, BVD, PI3, BRSV (Bovi-shield, Triangle, Virashield, etc) vaccination is required not less than 14 days or more than 90 days from date of sale.
- c. Strongly Recommended – vaccination with Inforce 3 within 30 days of sale.

SALE MANAGEMENT NOTE: Please do not send cattle with active ringworm or warts. They will not be accepted into the sale.

Social Media and video will be used heavily to promote and sell the live cattle. Please make sure that your consignments are trained on a halter so that sales staff can have your consignments looking their best for potential buyers.
